GENERAL

Band entries must be postmarked by February 13th, 2024. Sign the release to be eligible for competition and to receive tickets to

Any ticket sent to a pipe band in excess of the number that actually play at the welcoming and awards ceremonies must be returned to the piping coordinator on the day of the games or SASSF reserves the right to deduct \$20 per ticket not returned from travel money.SASSF reserves the right to remove events from the schedule and to make other changes as long as its action is within the scope of the EUSPBA rules and is, in its judgment, in the best interests of the Games.

Decision of the judges on performance is final.

Contest Committee members will be available at the registration area. All protests shall be made in writing and lodged with the Contest Committee, if applicable before the end of the Games in question. All protests shall be dealt with by the Contest Committee.

Competitors in sanctioned events must compete in appropriate Highland dress and remain in competition attire until all trophies have been awarded

There must be one or more bands than prizes to be awarded. i.e. if there are three competitors, two prizes will be awarded.

Hold Harmless

It is my express intent that this Waiver of Liability and Hold Harmless Agreement shall bind the members of my family and spouse, if I am alive, and my heirs, assigns and personal representative, if I am deceased, and shall be deemed as a **RELEASE**. WAIVER, DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE the above-named RELEASEES.

Force Maieure

In the event of a Force Majeure, an event beyond the control of the participant and the Scottish American Society of South Florida, which prevents either party from complying with any of its obligations under this contract, including, but not limited to, Acts of God, such as fires, explosions, earthquakes, drought, hurricanes, tidal waves, and floods, war, hostilities, rebellion, riot, strikes, lockouts or disorder, acts of threats or terrorism, order of any governmental authority, pandemic, or any other cause not reasonably within the control of the participant and/or the Scottish American Society of South Florida and which by the exercise of due diligence, the non-performing party is unable in whole or in part to prevent or overcome, then, in that event, the non-performing party shall be excused from complying with any of its obligations under the terms of this contract and concomitantly, the performing party shall likewise be similarly excused from complying with any of its obligations under the terms of this contract.
