ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

The Scottish American Society of South Florida (SASSF) awards funds in support of further education to selected candidates having their homes in Monroe, Dade, and Broward or Palm Beach counties. Applicants must be students who have graduated from high school or will graduate in 2020, and will attend or are attending any accredited technical, college or university program. The awards are paid directly to the educational institution.

SASSF reserves the right to fund the scholarships on an annual basis. Accordingly, there is no fixed monetary value to an award, nor are there a specific number of awards to be made. Awards have historically been between \$500 and \$1000.

For the academic scholarship year 2020-2021 applications must be received or postmarked no later than:

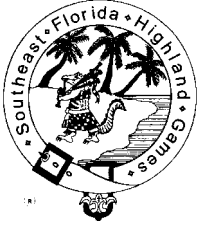
April 15, 2020

Awards will be decided by May 15, 2020.

The requirements for the academic scholarship are as follows:

- A. A completed application form identifying the applicant, the institution and the program in which the student intends to matriculate.
- B. A copy of the most recent record of academic performance (report card or transcript) if available, or a recommendation by someone knowledgeable about the applicant's ability and potential.
- C. An original essay of 500 to 1000 words, prepared for the purpose of this scholarship application, on a feature or features of Scotland, its heritage, or its people, their descendants, and their contributions in any part of the world. The essay will be judged on its presentation, content and originality. All sources must be credited. Due consideration will be given to the applicant's level in school. SASSF reserves the right to use the essay, in whole or in part, in the program for the annual Scottish Festival and Games and other publications with credit to the author.
- D. A small portrait photograph (may be printed in the Festival program if you receive a scholarship).
- E. An interview with the scholarship committee may be required.
- F. The Scholarship recipient is required to perform 10 hours of volunteer service for SASSF in the award year.
